We operate a smart/casual dress code. The information below should be used as a guideline only and the final decision as to what is appropriate rests with the Post 16 staff and Senior Leadership Team. Students not dressed in line with the code will be sent home to change and expected to make up any lesson time lost.

Clean, smart jeans or trousers	 Ripped/ frayed/ distressed jeans or trousers Tracksuit bottoms Sports leggings
Clean, smart shorts that come down at least to mid-thigh	 Swim shorts, sports shorts, ripped/ frayed/ distressed shorts
 Skirt/dresses must come to at least finger tips Thick, black leggings worn with a top that comes down to at least midthigh 	 Shorts that do not reach at least mid-thigh Leggings worn with a short top Cycling shorts
Clean, smart t-shirts/ polo shirts/ button-up shirts/ jumpers	Ripped/frayed/distressed tops and offensive branding
Clean, smart tops with wide straps that fit to jeans/ skirts or to mid-thigh if wearing leggings	 Vest tops Crop tops Tops where underwear is visible (including bra straps) or have midriff showing
Shoes/ trainers/ canvas-style shoesSandals with support around the back	Flip-flops, sliders or open backed sandals
