Enterprise and entrepreneurship – students will have an understanding of the skills that a business owner needs and why these are important	Able to construct a logical chain of argument detailing why the skills is needed and the help that this provides to the business
Spotting a business opportunity – students will gain an understanding how a business looks at gaining knowledge and information to see opportunities available to them	Students will be able to select skills that have been important in the scenario given and explain in a logical chain of argument finishing with a clear judgement.
Putting a business idea in to practice – students will see how they take a business idea and develop in to a functioning business	Students will be able to identify the stages that have occurred and be able to select the information that show that the idea has been a success from a given case study..
Production methods – what are these and how and why they vary from business to business	Students will be able to identify the production method and construct a coherent argument for the choice using a case study or business scenario given
Making the business effective - students will understand how businesses try and remain successful what information they use and how they use it	Students will be able to recall and define key business terminology to help with explanations
Understanding external influences – students will understand the external pressures that business face and how these affect decision making of the business	Students will be able to apply knowledge to a business scenario. In this area they will be able to identify the external pressure from the information provided and form a logical chain of reasoning
