# maximising potential

Belfairs Academy is an all ability **academy** that provides challenge and motivation to every student. At Belfairs our inclusive ethos recognises that students should be educated in a way which enables them to work at the highest level matched to their ability and interest, both for the good of others and for their own satisfaction.

Just as we make appropriate provision for students with special educational needs, we also provide rich and challenging experiences for our more able, gifted and talented children. Our Gifted and Talented programme aims to nurture and develop those students who show a particular flair or capacity for greater depth of learning. Our provision includes:

- Excellence classes
- In-depth additional learning
- Additional support for our EAL (English as an Additional Language)

In order to provide the appropriate challenges for all our students, the academy provides a stretching experience both inside and outside the classroom. Students are monitored and supported to ensure that the curriculum provides sufficient challenge, that they are achieving their potential, and that they are given opportunities to participate in enrichment activities.

The academy complies with the Special Education Needs (SEN) Code of Practice and, as far as reasonably practical those with physical and learning disabilities will be offered maximum access to the curriculum.



Students attending Belfairs Academy are offered to continue their journey into Post 16 education. Our expectations of high standards and provision of quality education presents students with a springboard into higher education.

#### Our Post 16 curriculum will:

- Develop skills for successful entry into university, employment or further training
- Support students through our Careers team, with guidance on University, mentoring and internships
- Ensure students develop into mature, independent learners with a professional attitude.
